
You can enjoy the wealth of restaurants on the dock front and go on a magical mystery tour of the wide variety of shops in the Liverpool One complex.

JOHN ANTHONY SPENCER

Consultant Radiologist at St James's Hospital 1992 - 2015

For as long as he was a radiologist, John Spencer was a committed and dedicated teacher who exuded enthusiasm for his specialism. His gift was the ability to transfer that sense to others, many of whom he inspired to achieve their career goals. John's humour and generosity resonated with many, making him an extremely popular and approachable consultant.

John was a consultant at St James's University Hospital, Leeds. Here he helped develop a multidisciplinary gynaecological cancer system in Yorkshire which was well ahead of the national curve. John became the lead radiologist for the Yorkshire cancer network from 1997 until his death. John's prowess and popularity as a teacher were widely known. He represented the Royal College of Radiologists (RCR) on many occasions as a highly acclaimed lecturer.

In 2000 he was the inaugural Roentgen professor of the RCR, and in 2009 he received the Rohan Williams travelling professorship. John also served the RCR on several of the standing committees including faculty board, council, and the journal editorial committee. Improving the quality and outcomes in the diagnosis and staging of malignant diseases was one of John's career goals. Through his work on executive committees of the International Cancer Imaging Society and the European Society of Uroradiology he led the development of cancer imaging guidelines. He co-authored several excellent clinical guidelines included algorithms for evaluation of ovarian and endometrial cancers as well as the investigation of abdominal pain in pregnancy.



RICHARD FARROW

Consultant Radiologist at Royal Cornwall Hospital 1995 - 2004

He died suddenly on April 5th as a result of hypertrophic cardiomyopathy. After qualification, Richard trained in Radiology in the South West before undertaking a fellowship at McMaster in Canada. During this period, he developed an enthusiasm for medical education and particularly problem based learning (PBL), which ultimately led to his appointment in 2002 as the first director of PBL at the Peninsula medical school. He was appointed as a consultant gastrointestinal radiologist in Truro in 1995 and latterly divided his time between his twin enthusiasms of medical education and abdominal radiology. He also found time to indulge in many other passions, including cycling, snowboarding, fishing and fine wine. His love of gadgets and understanding of information technology led to his being much in demand for the design and creation of websites for many national and European medical societies.

His exceptional abilities were recognised by his radiology colleagues with a series of posts in the national gastrointestinal radiology special interest group, of which he had recently been elected secretary, and European Society of Gastrointestinal and Abdominal Radiology (ESGAR), for which he was the UK national representative.

His essential qualities were a love of learning and a continuous desire to assist the learning of others, a fundamental belief in the value of a small group or team for learning and working and an unremittingly positive approach to life.

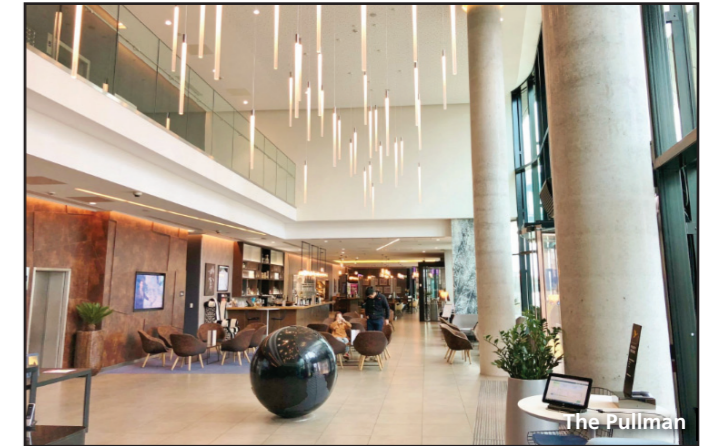

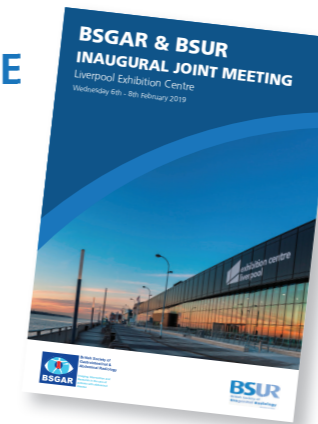
