

Invitation to participate in National CT Colonography Report Coding Survey (UK)

We would like to invite CT Colonography reporters within the UK to contribute to his national survey on the use of Bowel Cancer Screening Programme (BCSP) C-codes. BSGAR are conducting this survey to build a picture of practice throughout the UK. ***This survey will close on 7th March 2025.***

What is the purpose of this study?

This project aims to survey the use of C-codes in CT Colonography (CTC) reporting within the United Kingdom amongst CTC reporters (radiologists and advanced practice CTC radiographers who verify reports). We plan to use the results of this survey to help us develop a lexicon to assist with standardisation of C-code use in the UK. Results will also be anonymised and presented at conferences and/or published.

Who can take part?

CTC reporters in England, Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland.

What will I have to do?

You will be asked a series of questions about your demographics and reporting practice, followed by some C-coding case scenarios. The survey should take approximately 15 minutes to complete. There is no time limit (although you must complete all sections in one sitting, as it cannot be saved to come back to). The survey is an online questionnaire on Google Forms.

No personal data about you will be collected beyond the NHS region you work within (not hospital specific). Your email address will be used solely to contact you with the results if you choose to opt in to receive this. These will not be shared with third parties or used for any purpose other than those directly related to this research.

What will happen to the results of the study?

We plan to use the results of this survey to help us develop a lexicon to assist with standardisation of C-code use in the UK. The results will be presented at conferences and/or published in a journal. At no time you will be identifiable as a respondent.
